

PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF NATO SECURITY POLICY DOCUMENTS

Reference: PO(90)32 (Revised)

1. The NATO Security Committee (NSC) received a request from a member nation to disclose to the public the following NATO Security Policy and related documents:

- C-M(2002)49, "Security Within NATO" and its five NATO UNCLASSIFIED supporting directives;
- C-M(2002)60, "The Management of non-Classified Information" and its implementing policy PO(99)47, "NATO Information Management Policy"
- PO(90)32(Revised), "Public Disclosure of NATO Documents".

The rationale for this request is that in accordance with this particular nation's legislation on public access to government information, it continually receives requests from private individuals conducting research on NATO classifications and security procedures for the disclosure to the public of these documents.

2. The NSC originated C-M(2002)49 and it has agreed under silence procedure¹ to recommend that Council approve the disclosure to the public of C-M(2002)49 and its supporting directive on the Security of Information (AC/35-D/2002). It did not agree to the disclosure of the four other NATO UNCLASSIFIED supporting directives.

3. The request with respect to PO(90)32(Revised) was passed to the Archives Committee. This latter body, as originator, agreed under the silence procedure² to recommend that the Council approve the disclosure to the public of this document.

4. PO(99)47, "NATO Information Management Policy" and C-M(2002)60, "The Management of non-classified Information" were originated by two Ad Hoc Committees which no longer exist. After due consideration, and in view of the decisions made by the NSC and the Archives Committee on the other two documents, the Director, NOS in his capacity as Chairman, NSC and the Chairman of the Archives Committee recommend that Council also approve the disclosure to the public of these two documents.

5. The current policy on the public disclosure of NATO UNCLASSIFIED information (see paragraph 3(c) of reference) allows for the disclosure of NU documents less than 30 years old when Council expresses its conviction that it would be in the best interests of NATO to do so. I believe on this occasion it is in the best interests of NATO to disclose these documents and put into practice the type of transparency several NATO nations are required to demonstrate under their freedom of information legislation.

6. I therefore recommend that Council approve the public disclosure of:

- C-M(2002)49 and its Supporting Directive on the Security of Information (AC/35-D/2002)
- PO(90)32 (Revised), "Public Disclosure of NATO Documents"
- C-M(2002)60, "The Management of non-Classified Information" and its implementing policy, PO(99)47, "NATO Information Management Policy"




